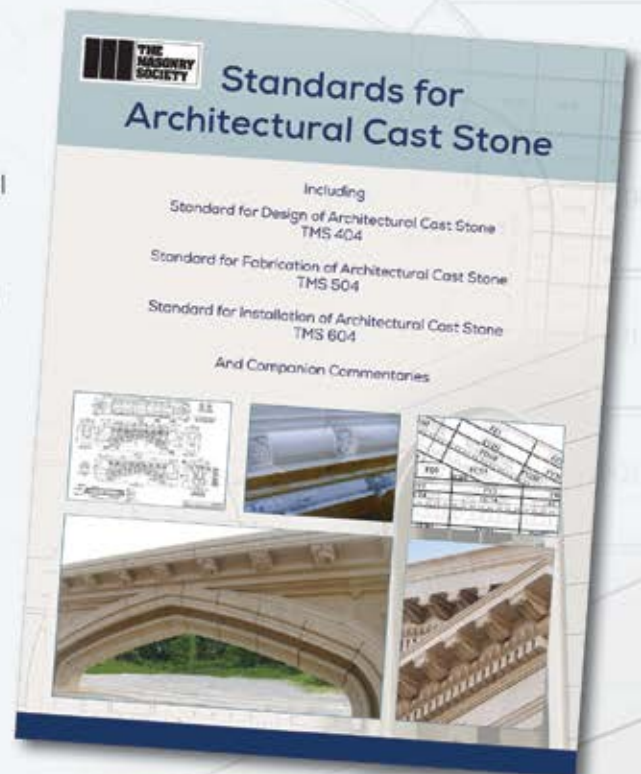
COURSE DESCRIPTION
